

Hartford Foundation Awards Grants to Operation Fuel

Hartford, Conn. -- The Hartford Foundation for Public Giving (HFPG) has awarded a total of \$82,553 in grants to Operation Fuel, which includes \$66,803 in grants for energy assistance and \$15,750 towards a financial management grant.

The following grants were awarded for energy assistance: \$46,803 through grants from the Beatrice Fox Auerbach Foundation Fund, \$5,000 through the Stanley D. and Hinda N. Fisher Fund, \$5,000 through the Budd Family Fund, \$5,000 through the Carol and Edward Wrobel Family Fund and one anonymous grant for \$5,000.

Operation Fuel is a statewide nonprofit organization that provides emergency energy assistance year-round to lower-income working families and individuals, the elderly, and disabled individuals who are in financial crisis.
