**Q: Is Operation Fuel currently accepting new applications?**

**A:** We are not currently accepting new applications as of March 6, 2023, however, we will begin accepting applications again on April 3, 2023.

**Q: Do I qualify for Operation Fuel assistance?**

**A:** Operation Fuel serves households whose income does not exceed 100% of the State Median Income Guidelines, which include, but are not limited to, the elderly, disabled, working families, or individuals facing a financial crisis.

**A:** You can meet in person to apply for assistance at one of Operation Fuel's partner Fuel Banks across the state of Connecticut. To find a Fuel Bank near you, call 2-1-1 or scan the QR code below.
